Poinciana Boulevard

Widening and Improvement Project



from Pleasant Hill Road to Trafalgar Boulevard

The purpose of this project is to widen Poinciana Boulevard Road from a two-lane road to a four-lane road from Pleasant Hill Road to Trafalgar. The project includes adding multi-modal accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists; enhancing drainage systems and stormwater ponds; and will include new signalization, lighting and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) components.

Noise, dust, and vibrations can be expected during construction. The construction work may require daytime and nighttime lane closures.

Expect traffic shifts to the new roadway as construction progresses. Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to direct the traffic. Motorists are asked to exercise caution and reduce their speed while driving through the work zone. The construction schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
