Osceola County has evaluated non-residential and industrial land countywide. As a result, land generally located east of Turn berry Boulevard and along Boggy Creek Road has been identified for an additional study and potential Future Land Use Map designation changes.

## FAQs

#### What is the purpose of this meeting?

The purpose of the meeting is to provide a summary of the community response data collected from Meeting 1 on February 23<sup>rd</sup> and showing potential opportunities and outcomes for property owners within the study area.

#### How does this impact existing development?

Future Land Use Map changes would not affect existing uses unless new development is proposed. New development is defined in the Land Development Code and generally includes construction on vacant land, new subdivisions, and building expansions of more than 5%. Development is not being proposed.

#### How does this impact future new development?


Future new development will have to rezone to a zoning district consistent with any Future Land Use Map changes. A new zoning district will change the permitted uses and performance standards of the property.
